

Breast Alteration & Lymphedema

Fitting Services - approximately 1hr

During your appointment, your fitter will complete an intake assessment and take measurements for compression, prosthesis, post-surgical, and/or post-mastectomy garments.

This information will allow the fitter to determine whether you need custom or off-the-shelf medical-grade product(s). You will then try on the products, and the fitter can then refine the selection to ensure the correct size and fit. At the same time, they comply with Lymphedema Therapist guidelines, Oncologists, and most importantly, Client Satisfaction.

Cranial Prosthetic Wigs

During your appointment, the fitter will begin taking measurements for the cranial prosthetic wig. Once the measurements are taken, the client and the fitter will discuss hair color and style, the use of human or synthetic hair or a blend, and how to care for the cranial prosthetic wig.
